(Determine the period in which these losses began to appear in the company's financial statements):	 The Company faced accumulated losses since 2019 due to higher-than-expected medical claims and lower investment returns. Additional losses were incurred from declining business due to a merger and acquisition project between 2020 till 2022, revaluation of assets, and restated financial statements for equity investment impairments. 		
Summary of the steps and initiatives undertaken by the company to address the accumulated losses:	In the second quarter of 2025, the company reported a net income after tax of AED 9.8 million, demonstrating a solid recovery from the AED 13 million net loss incurred during the same period last year. This positive performance was driven by improved operational efficiency, disciplined cost control, and a well-executed investment strategy. Moreover, following the capital injection in December 2024, the company's solvency metrics have remained strong and consistently in line with regulatory requirements, further reinforcing its financial stability and resilience. This financial strength enables the company to actively pursue strategic growth opportunities, invest in innovation, and expand its product offerings. Furthermore, sound financial position facilitates improved underwriting capacity and operational flexibility, both of which

The company is implementing a strategic plan aimed at building a strong and profitable business foundation, with an emphasis on sustainable growth and enhanced underwriting performance.

By adopting revised investment strategies, the company has achieved a notable improvement in net investment income, demonstrating effective portfolio management and better alignment with market conditions.

The company achieved significant growth in Takaful revenues compared to the same period last year, recording an increase of 49% to reach AED 284 million. This performance reflects strong business momentum and an enhanced market position.
