#### REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM FINANCIAL INFORMATION

### 1 Legal status and activities

Watania International Holding (PJSC) was incorporated as a public joint stock company. During the year 2023, the Company's insurance license has been cancelled as it will be an investment holding company and changed its name from Dar Al Takaful (PJSC) to Watania International Holding (PJSC). The address of the Company is P.O. Box 235353, Dubai, United Arab Emirates.

The Company obtained its commercial license on 23 July 2008 and commenced operations on 1 September 2008.

The condensed interim financial information has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the applicable laws and regulations, including UAE Federal Law No. (32) of 2021.

The primary activity of the company includes investment in subsidiaries and securities such as agricultural, commercial, educational, energy, industrial, technological, and tourist enterprises & management, outer space projects, health care, sports, and water enterprises & development, oil & natural gas projects.

The Company with its subsidiaries is together referred to as the "Group" in this condensed interim consolidated financial information. Set out below are the details of the principal subsidiaries held directly by the Company, in UAE which is the country of their incorporation and principal place of business:

#### 2 Basis of preparation

The condensed interim consolidated financial information are for the six-month period ended 30 June 2025 and are presented in United Arab Emirate Dirham (AED), which is also the functional currency of the Group. This condensed interim consolidated financial information have been prepared in accordance with IAS 34 'Interim Financial Reporting' and complies with the applicable requirements of the laws in the U.A.E. The condensed consolidated interim financial information does not include all the information required in annual financial information in accordance with IFRS Accounting Standards ("IFRS") and should be read in conjunction with the consolidated financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2024. Further, results for interim periods are not necessarily indicative of the results that may be expected for the financial year ending 31 December 2025.

The Group presents its condensed interim consolidated statement of financial position broadly in order of liquidity, with a distinction based on expectations regarding recovery or settlement within twelve months after the reporting date (current) and more than twelve months after the reporting date (non-current).

### **Basis of consolidation**

The condensed interim consolidated financial information comprise the financial information of the Group and its subsidiaries as at 30 June 2025.

Control is achieved when the Company is exposed, or has rights, to variable returns from its involvement with the investee and has the ability to affect those returns through its power over the investee. Specifically, the Company controls an investee if, and only if, the Company has:

- power over the investee (i.e., existing rights that give it the current ability to direct the relevant activities of the investee);
- exposure, or rights, to variable returns from its involvement with the investee; and
- the ability to use its power over the investee to affect its returns.

### 2 Basis of preparation (continued)

#### **Basis of consolidation (continued)**

Generally, there is a presumption that a majority of voting rights result in control. To support this presumption and when the Company has less than a majority of the voting or similar rights of an investee, the Company considers all relevant facts and circumstances in assessing whether it has power over an investee, including:

- the contractual arrangement with the other vote holders of the investee
- rights arising from other contractual arrangements
- the Company's voting rights and potential voting rights

A change in the ownership interest of a subsidiary, without a loss of control, is accounted for as an equity transaction.

If the Company loses control over a subsidiary, it derecognises the related assets (including goodwill), liabilities, non-controlling interest and other components of equity while any resultant gain or loss is recognised in profit or loss. Any investment retained is recognised at fair value.

### 3 Material accounting policy information

The accounting policies used in the preparation of this condensed interim consolidated financial information are consistent with those used in the audited consolidated financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2024, except for application of new standards effective as of January 2025 and several amendments and interpretations apply for the first time in 2025.

### Standards, interpretations and amendments to existing standards

The Group has not early adopted any standard, interpretation or amendment that has been issued but not yet effective.

#### Critical accounting estimates and judgments in applying accounting policies

The preparation of this condensed interim consolidated financial information requires management to make judgements, estimates and assumptions that effect the application of accounting policies and the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, income, and expense. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

In preparing this condensed interim consolidated financial information, the significant judgements made by management in applying the accounting policies and the key sources of estimation uncertainty were the same as those that were applied in the audited consolidated financial statements as at and for the year ended 31 December 2024.

#### Insurance and financial risk management

The Group's insurance and financial risk management objectives and policies are consistent with those disclosed in the audited consolidated financial statements as at and for the year ended 31 December 2024. There have been no changes in any risk management policies since the year end.

### 4 Investment properties

Investment properties comprise of buildings which are located in United Arab Emirates.

Management estimates that there has been no change in the fair value of investment properties during the sixmonth period ended 30 June 2025. The carrying value of the investment properties as at 30 June 2025 is AED 73.07 million (31 December 2024: AED 73.07 million). Investment properties are classified as Level 3 in the fair value hierarchy as at 30 June 2025 (31 December 2024: Level 3).

#### 10 Reserves

#### Statutory reserve

In accordance with U.A.E. Law No. (32) of 2021, the Group has established a statutory reserve by appropriation of 10% of profit for each year until the reserve equals 50% of the paid-up share capital. This reserve is not available for distribution except as stipulated by the Law. No transfer to the statutory reserve has been made during the six-months period ended 30 June 2025 (30 June 2024: Nil), as this will be based on the annual results for the year-end.

#### Restricted reserve

This reserve pertains to the subsidiaries which are takaful entities, and in accordance with article 34 of Central Bank of UAE' Board of Directors Decision No. 23 of 2019, concerning instructions organising Retakaful operations, the reserve is not available for distribution and will not be disposed of without prior approval from Central Bank of UAE. No transfer to the restricted reserve has been made during the sixmonth period ended 30 June 2025 (six-month period ended 30 June 2024: Nil), as this will be based on the annual results for the year-end.

### Treasury shares

The Group engaged a third-party licensed Market Maker on the Dubai Financial Market that offers liquidity provision services, to place buy and sell orders of the Company's shares with the objective of reducing bid/ask spreads as well as reducing price and volume volatility. At 30 June 2025, the Market Maker held 12,788,139 (December 31, 2024: 7,553,607) of Watania International Holding PJSC's shares on behalf of the Company, which are classified under equity as treasury shares at par value of AED 1 at 30 June 2025. During the period, the Company recorded Treasury Shares reserves of AED 4.0 million (December 31, 2024: AED 2.3 million) to reflect the discount on the acquisition of treasury shares.

At the end of the contract term with the Market Maker, the Company will have the option to either transfer the outstanding shares under its name or dispose of the shares in the market.

#### 12 **Borrowings**

The Group obtained a Murabaha facility of AED 100 million with ENBD group (34.7 million on 30th January 2025 and 65.3 million on 10th Feb 2025) held at amortised cost. The facility was arranged to settle the previous facility balloon payment of 34.7M due in 2025 and intercompany balances of Watania Takaful General PISC "WTG" and Watania Takaful Family PISC "WTF".

Total facility of AED 100 million carrying flexible profit rate of 3 months EIBOR plus 1.75% having a maturity period of 4 years with one year moratorium.

Other Murabaha arrangements are as follows:

#### Pledged collateral

- Pledger over Wakala deposits valued up to AED 100 million;
- Pledge over the shares of target entities i.e. WTF and WTG;
- A profit service reserve account will be maintained by the Company with bank that holds 6 months of profit service for outstanding facility amount at all the times;
- All proceeds from the operating target entities shall be deposited into a dividend account that the Company maintains with the bank; and
- Pledge over profit service reserve account and dividend account maintained with the bank.

#### Financial covenants

- A minimum capital requirement of AED 200 million.
- A minimum solvency coverage ratio of 100%.
- A minimum special purpose Liquid Assets Cover (cash plus marketable securities) of 100%; and
- Compliance with minimum guaranteed fund and net admissible assets requirements.

#### 15 Corporate Tax

On 9 December 2022, the United Arab Emirates (UAE) Ministry of Finance ("MoF") released Federal Decree-Law No. 47 of 2022 on the Taxation of Corporations and Businesses, Corporate Tax ("CT") to enact a new CT regime in the UAE. The new CT regime has become effective for accounting periods beginning on or after 1 June 2023. Recently, in order to align with OECD's Global Minimum Tax effort (Pillar Two), the UAE Ministry of Finance (MoF) has introduced a Domestic Minimum Top-Up Tax of 15% for Multinational Enterprises (MNEs) with effect from financial years starting on or after 1st January 2025. It is not foreseen that the Group's operations will be subject to the application of the Global Minimum Tax rate of 15%.

#### 22. Prior year adjustments and comparative information

The comparative amounts as at 31 December 2024 and 1 January 2024 and for the six month period ended 30 June 2024 have been restated due to correction of prior period errors relating to the insurance portfolios acquired upon business combinations. The IFRS 4 intangibles should have been derecognized and consolidation adjustments eliminating deferred acquisition costs should have been no longer required upon first-time adoption of IFRS 17 that came into effect on the 1st of January 2023. The inaccurate recording of the insurance portfolio resulted in the overstatement of the intangible assets, understatement of the trade and other receivables and overstatement of the deferred tax liabilities.

In accordance with the requirements of 'IAS 1 Presentation of Financial Statements' and 'IAS 8 Accounting policies, Changes in Estimates and Errors', the above items have been corrected retrospectively and accordingly balances in the financial statements as at 31 December 2024 and 1 January 2024 and for the six month period ended 30 June 2024 have been restated as follows:
